Financial records and bookkeeping is fully in house as of August 1st.

FYE June 2016 Financials are not final due to double booking of cemetery granite bill, all other items are correct. July 2016 financials are on hold until June is complete, however, both should be done shortly.

Church Windows: North side and alter windows will be removed the morning of 8/16. Storm windows will remain in place and ventilators will be covered.

Parking Lot Resurfacing: Rocks should be swept up mid-August.

Cemetery Crucifix: Sizing of certain remaining materials being corrected.

Parishioners' Request: Can a Diocese-wide calendar of events be created and posted/available to parishioners?

Joint Parish Fundraising Meeting: To be schedule after Faith Formation begins. Possible dates include September 19th or 26th. Looking for representatives from the FC and PC of both Parishes to attend the meeting.

Motion to approve Laura Templin's letter to the Parish regarding fundraising. Motion approved.

FR Report:

- Faith Formation – combining the Parish's' programs in effort to strengthen the program and share resources. Upper grade levels (6-8) will be taught under the Edge Program. Catechist of the Good Shepard (levels I-II) taught to -preK-2nd graders.

- Integration of Parish into Faith Formation – greeters will be at each evening of classes, and a community meal will be served. Adoration for 3-6th graders to be offered, and father will be working to integrate Faith Formation in his Sunday homilies.
- Children Stewardship – giving of time and treasure
- Parish Council is focusing on a faith strategy for St. Bernard's and considering concepts from the book, Divine Renovation
- Greeter training – how to properly welcome parishioners and guests
- Developing a Catholic Watchman's Group – Men's group through the archdiocese. Meets once per month and has an outreach element to it.
- Administrative support and structure getting stronger each month, and provides much needed support to Father and the Parishes.
- Challenge Areas:
 - Transition plan for convent and school buildings
 - Shared administrator and physically moving back and forth between parishes – purchase of a parish paid cell phone for administrator.
 - Parking lot and accessibility- the hill can be a challenge for some
 - Seating is limited at each Parish
 - 4 masses each weekend is too much for one priest.
Formal mass count should be performed.
 - Ability to engage parishioners and non-parishioners
- Father is on vacation the 3rd week of October
