Approved Oct and Nov minutes after a few modifications made to the Oct minutes.

Financial Report update

- Collections are \$17,000 behind budget
- Total expenses are \$12,000 less than budget

Faith Formation

• Expenses are running over budget, primarily due to the weekly meal program, resulting in an expected shortfall of \$9,000. Financial donations are being sought out.

There are still pending pledges.

Ongoing Progress Updates Building and Grounds

- Window Restoration Donations of time, talent and materials have been received from parishioners to assist with cost. With the Forward in Faith plus the pledges, the Window fund has received \$73,761.
- Roof loan A motion was made and approved to pay down the loan principal by \$10,000.
- School All of the computers have been remove/donated. The boiler was identified to have a crack which will cost apx \$5,000 for welding.
- Cemetery no updates.
- Air Conditioner Sherry to contact Greg's Heating and Air Conditioning to confirm past quote.
- Sherry No meetings this month.
 - Mass counts Oct averaged 102 for Saturday and 134 for Sunday. November averaged 95 for Saturday and 98 for Sunday
 - o Reminder Saturday, Dec 31st will be the last day for 2016 donations. Anything received on Sunday will be included in the 2017 financials.
 - o 5 Scholarships for Catholic Education were provided (\$1,000 each)
 - Snow removal 3 bids were received. The hourly bid (\$70/hr) was selected.
 - o Thank you was sent to the Cologne Fire Dept for the \$4,000 donation towards the fire prevention at St. Bernard.
 - o Pam is retiring in 2017. More details to come.
- Christmas gifts The Ladies Guild provided a \$25 gift card from Holiday to Father, Pam, Sherry and Bob Symanitz.
- Fr. Gregory's Report
 - o Faith Formation meal sponsorship goal of \$5,000 for both parishes.
 - B&G Committee Invited all parish members.
 - o FC mtgs—Discussion around monthly or other frequencies were discussed. Agreed that meeting monthly would continue but the financial reports would be reviewed quarterly.
 - o Stewardship- mailings were sent out with 45 responses so far.
