The objective of our group is to minimize the sense of duty and obligation so that you can take a break from your hectic life, refresh your soul with uninterrupted time to focus on Christ among friends.

We meet in the narthex at St Bernard's Saturday mornings from 8:30 am to 10 am. Sessions typically run for 4 to 5 consecutive weeks. A scripture reading with a few questions are sent out via email prior to the gathering. There is no obligation to prepare for the Saturday morning, though reading through the scripture may help you dive deeper in conversation. A light breakfast and coffee is served. We pray, read the scripture, and discuss questions that help us understand the passage deeper and relate the readings to our busy lives. We end the morning of discussion with prayer. If you are unable to attend a Saturday, you will not miss out or "fall behind". Each week is a separate reading and allows for new discussion.

We begin a new five week session on October 7th. We are exploring "*A Scriptural Journey with Mary.*" Who better exemplifies motherhood and serves as a role model to women than the mother of Christ? We will focus on different scripture verses that help us gain a deeper appreciation and understanding of Mary. Please join us!
