April Financial Reports, Sherry

- Revenues for the month are \$3,700 less than budget. Year to date revenues are \$25,000 higher than budget.
- Expenses are running near budget.
- Year to date net income of \$43,000.

Motion approved to table the decision regarding the choir stairs.

Church Steeple: Contract with Lifetime Shingles, LLC. has been signed and down payment sent in.

Bat remediation – first half of invoice has been paid, working to schedule a time for work to be completed.

Approved filling in the pea rock at the playground to meet insurance requirements. Cost expected to be minimal.

June 1959 \$1,200 redecorating of sanctuary of church

February 1961 \$1,700 new light fixtures in church

March 1962 \$3,000 repair of church ceiling

March 1963 \$5,000 redecorating of church

March 1964 \$2,000 enclose North and South entrance of church

March 1976 proxy to spend \$42,000 for church repair

August 1978 removal of sanctuary curtain

October 1980 redecorating contract with Liturgical Arts Co. Mankato, MN

February 1981 fans installed in church

1985 repair stained glass windows

April 2008, proxy \$79,756 new seating and carpet

July 2008, proxy \$91,000 new heating system

4. Electric items must be in working order (e.g. tools, appliances, etc.)
5. Clothing must be in clean, usable condition-not stained or in need of repair.
6. Please remove all garage sale tags.
7. No encyclopedia sets or window blinds will be accepted.
8. No Infant Car Seats, High chairs, Cribs etc. We are not allowed to sell these items because of safety codes.
