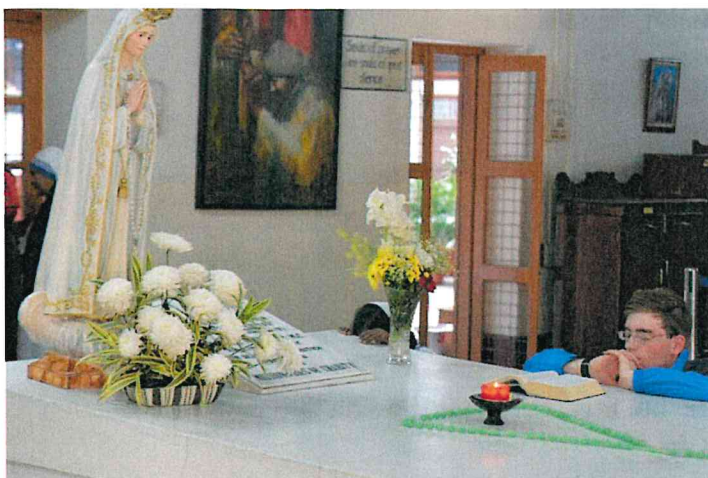

To the left is a picture of me with a few men from Mother Teresa's leper colony. Below is Kalighat, Mother Teresa's home for the dying.



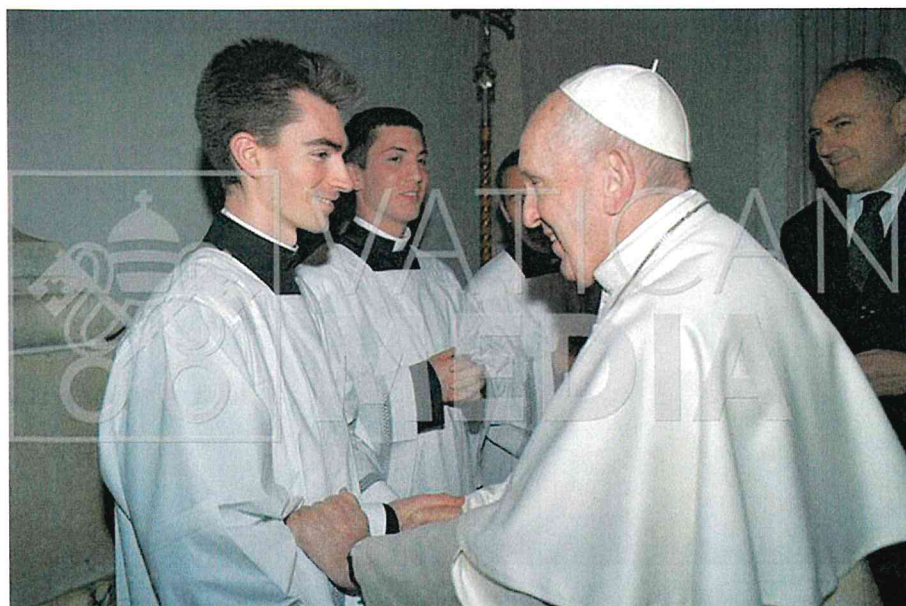
To the left is one of my seminarian friends at the tomb of Mother Teresa. Below is me meeting Pope Francis in Rome.
