



## Twelfth Sunday In Ordinary Time June 20, 2021

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Many of us know how frightening a storm can be with wind and water raging around us. Storms are part of human experiences. There is no life without a storm. And this storm can take various dimensions in our lives. In today's first reading, we hear of God's response to Job's complaints about the numerous and almost continuous storms in his life (Job 38: 1, 8-11). Like Job in the first reading, the disciples began to panic in the face of challenges and called out in fear: "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" (Mk 4, 38). Jesus rebuked the wind and commanding the sea to be still. All we need do as Jesus pointed out, is to trust and have faith in the power of God to save us.

We face a lot of storms in our lives. At times, they can become so strong that our human strength can no longer support us. At such moments fear and complains might take over the central stage of our life. Even in some cases, we might lose our faith in God, thinking that he has abandoned us or that he does not exist. These storms come in different forms. They could be: problems in marriage and family life, lack of a good job, poor finance, or a prolonged sickness that has defiled all treatments. They could also be the inability to find or maintain a good and stable relationship or, falling out with people all the time. They could also be poor results in our academics or business. The list is unending, but these represent the realities we face every day. The truth is that, there is no assurance that our lives would be completely free of storms. However, the good news is that, there is an assurance that Christ is with us to help us. Jesus has come into the world to calm the storms of our lives and bring about peace in our troubled situations.

God who creates all things controls everything. There is no situation that is so chaotic that God cannot calm and create something surprisingly good out of it. It was when Job realized that God triumph over all sufferings that he overcame his own sufferings (Job 38:11). It was when the disciples cried out for help, Jesus stilled the storm (Mk 4:39). Our Lord intervened because he assured us: "*Call on me on the day of distress, I will rescue you*" (Ps 50: 15). We are not alone. The Lord is always with us. We have to be aware of his presence in our lives and rely on the supreme power of God. Let us cry out to God, as the Apostles did, in our stormy moments.


As we cry out, we need to keep our trust fixed on God. God is never in a hurry but he is always on time. God always delivers those who put their trust in him and even when he is seemingly silent, he is doing something for our good. As we renew our trust in the Lord this day, may our faith never fail us. And may the Lord calm every storm ragging in our lives.

**Father's Day:** This weekend we celebrate and pray for the men who continue to reflect the divine qualities of fatherhood as they lovingly nourish and maintain a family. Fathers are a blessing, and we thank them for blessing us with lives of dedication, endurance and love. On this Father's Day we pray for our dads, whether they are near or far away, living or deceased. It is not easy being a faithful and loving father. St. Joseph, earthly father of Jesus, is the model of fatherhood. His faith and obedience to God inspired his devotion for his family. The significance of St. Joseph's presence in Jesus' life reminds us how important fathers are in our lives. Father's Day is also a day to remember, acknowledge and appreciate the love and providence of our Heavenly Father. Let the earthly fathers draw strength from their Heavenly Father. **Happy Father's Day.**

We were notified by the Archdiocese on June 3rd that the dispensation for attending Sunday Masses will be lifted. **"Now, as the pandemic subsides, and public gathering restrictions and safety protocols are lifted, it is time to gather as the Body of Christ once again. Therefore, the bishops and diocesan administrators of the Minnesota Catholic Conference have decided to reinstate the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation beginning the weekend of July 3-4, 2021."**


