## Registration for CI: Pillars Program (2021-2023) Class of St. Joseph

Applications for the **Archbishop Flynn Catechetical Institute** are now being taken for the **in-person** 2-year foundational Pillars Program beginning fall 2021. The two-year class will be held **in person** on Monday evenings at Transfiguration Catholic Church, Oakdale, MN.

The foundational course at the Catechetical Institute is *Pillars: A Journey through the Catechism of the Catholic Church*. In essence, the *Catechism* is seen as the road map for the journey in faith, with each module of the four-module program focusing on one of the four pillars of the *Catechism*:

Creed: The Story in Miniature  
Sacraments: The Blessing Revealed and Communicated  
The Moral Life: Fulfillment in Beatitude  
Prayer: The Blessing Given and Received

The course is available at the following CI Satellite Sites, where students will gather at the parish for in-person small group and watch the lectures live-streamed from Transfiguration.
