St. Bernard Parish Family is pleased to support Catholic Education. Our goal is to keep active young families as members of St. Bernard Parish. Active St. Bernard parishioners who are registered members at St. Bernard – and who do not otherwise qualify for a tuition discount or subsidy by reason of also being a member of the host school’s parish – are invited to submit this form (annually) to request tuition assistance for their children who are enrolled in kindergarten through 12th grade in a neighboring Catholic School for the coming year. All completed request forms must be received by the Parish Office before July 1, 2022 in order to be considered for tuition assistance for the 2022-23 school year. LATE REQUESTS WILL BE CONSIDERED BY THE PARISH PASTOR AND THE PARISH COUNCILS IF A FAMILY HAS RECENTLY MOVING INTO THE AREA AND HAS JOINED ST. BERNARD’S PARISH. All disbursements will be sent in equal amounts directly to the school (at the end of December and in May), provided the student remains so enrolled.
