They caught no fish. Jesus told them to throw the net on the other side of the boat. Then they caught 153 fish!

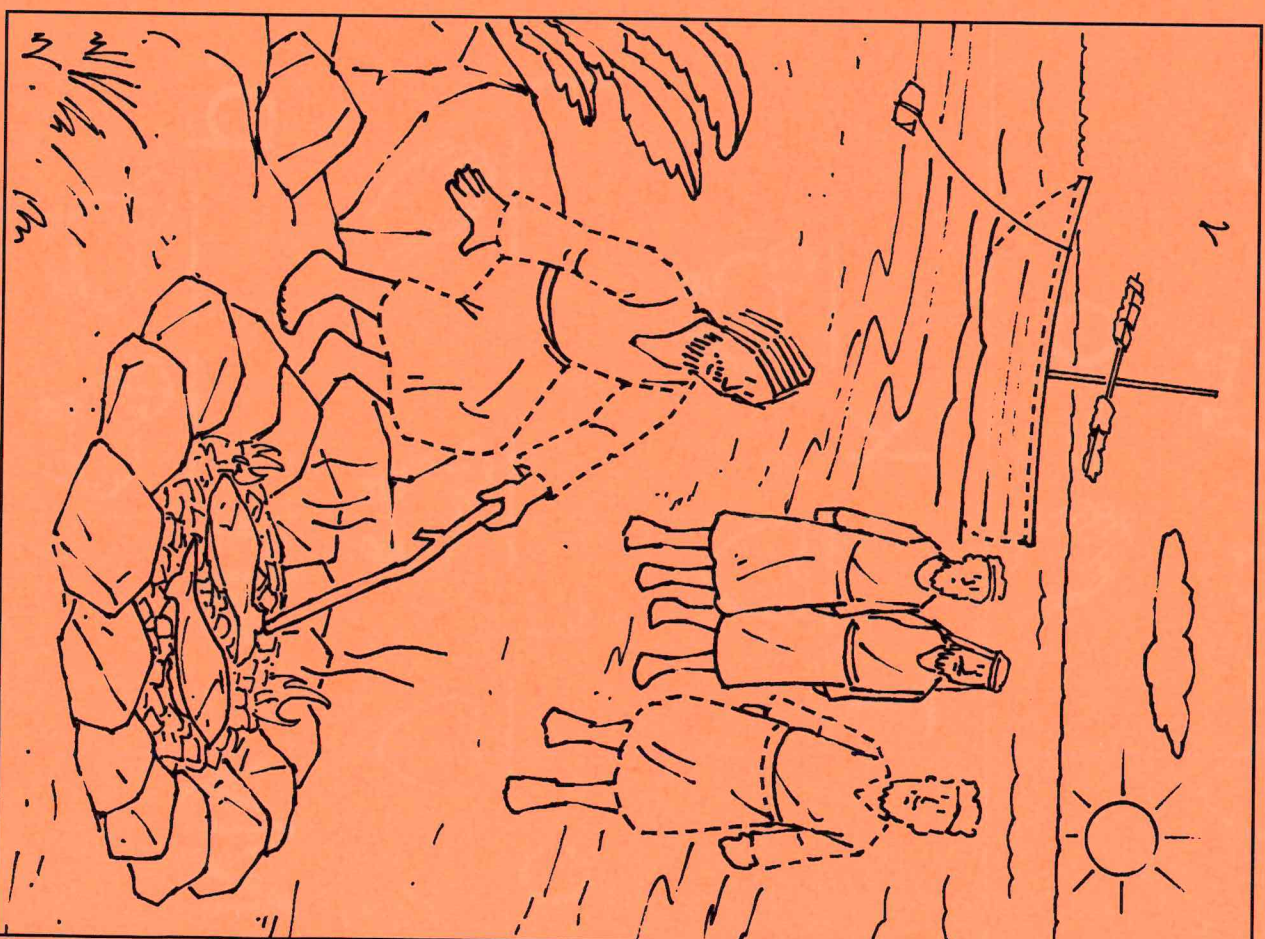
Count these fish and circle the correct number.

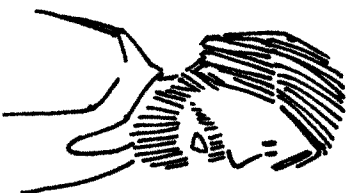
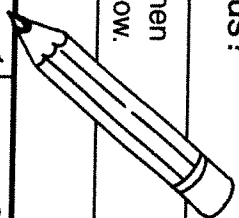


1. Cross out all 2-digit numbers
