



## First Sunday of Lent - February 25 & 26, 2023

### Victory over Temptations

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

We enter once more into the holy Season of Lent by receiving ashes in the form of a cross on our foreheads. It symbolizes the purpose of these 40 days: to unite ourselves with Jesus in his Passion, Death and Resurrection. The Church assigns temptation stories to the beginning of Lent because temptations come not only to Jesus, but to all of us. We are tempted to seek sinful pleasures, easy way to acquire wealth, power and glory. We are tempted to use unjust or sinful means, to gain worldly things. Jesus gave us the best example to conquer our temptations. It is through fasting, prayer, and the effective use of the ‘Word of God.’

During this Lent, let us conquer our temptations and evil tendencies by fasting, reading of the Holy Bible, daily prayers, especially by participating regularly in the holy Mass on Sundays. If you are not a weekday Mass participant, consider participating in at least one weekday Mass in a week during this Lenten Season. We should renew our lives by true repentance and through the sacrament of reconciliation. We have Lenten Reconciliation on Wednesday, March 22 at 6.30 pm at Ascension. You are invited to find some time for Eucharistic Adoration, and Stations of the Cross. We should reform our lives by sharing our love through selfless service, alms-giving and helping those in need.

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays in Lent. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to **fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. On these two days of fast, only one full meal is recommended. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one’s needs.

This weekend is the **Catholic Services Appeal Commitment Weekend**. This year’s Catholic Services Appeal theme is “*For the love of Christ impels us... to believe in the power of giving.*” Christ’s love impels us to share our gifts with others and CSA makes it easy to give to so many in need right here in our Archdiocese.

CSA is focused on four major ministry areas that touch on important areas of our Catholic life: To nurture, sustain, protect life, and affirm the dignity of every person. To serve those most in need, strengthen the faith, and support future leaders of our Church. To support Synod, Evangelization priorities of our Church, expressing the Good News of Jesus. To educate children and young adults in safe and healthy environments that provide both academic and spiritual growth.

The 2023 Appeal goal for St. Bernard is \$11,185.86 and for Ascension is \$9,258.48. This goal is 5% of our plate and envelope. Catholic Services Appeal is a very effective way to support ministries outside of our parish boundaries. I ask you to make a generous contribution.


#### **Fish Fry**

The Spirit leads Jesus into the desert to be tempted by the devil, and we hear this: “He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was hungry.” Seems like a questionable battle preparation plan. When I fast, I usually feel grouchy at best, and at worst, like I might pass out from longing for a hamburger. Isn’t it better to be well-fed and fully hydrated, especially to face spiritual struggles? Why fast?

This might help. The origin of the word “fast” means to “hold firmly.” We still use it that way when we say, “I held fast to my original decision.” We human beings are a bundle of desires which vie for our attention: food, drink, comfort, safety, sex, laughter, beauty, and so on. If we can’t manage to have firm grip on them, in short order they’ll have a firm grip on us. By fasting from our lower desires, we learn to firmly grip on to what is greater. Fasting leads us to a firmer hold on our body and mind.

Jesus fasts for us. He’s showing us that his grace can help us regain this firm hold of our lives, which makes it more difficult for the devil to tempt us. But take it one more step. Fasting also teaches us to finally hold fast to Jesus, the Word of God in flesh. “Man does not live by bread alone,” he says, “But by every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.” Jesus’ fasting reveals his fast hold to the Father in everything. May our fasting help us to grasp ourselves more firmly, and then to hold fast to Jesus alone. —Father John Muir ©LPI


