



## Third Sunday of Lent - March 11 & 12, 2023

### **Jesus Satisfies our thirst for Eternal Life**

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The story of the Samaritan woman at the well centers on the theme of eternal life. When Jesus encountered the woman, he broke the normal practice of Jews and asked her for a drink. And so, he initiates this fascinating dialogue on two levels. He is speaking about the living water and the life of grace, while the Samaritan woman is thinking only of the water in the well. Jesus said to her, “Everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks the water that I shall give will never thirst. The woman said to him, “Sir, give me this water, so that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw.”

In every human heart there is a thirst that no water can satisfy. There is restlessness that no success can satisfy. But God has provided us a way to satisfy our inner thirst for him. He has given us Living Water through his Son Jesus. The Living Water which Christ gives is God’s life. Hence St Paul would say that on our baptism, “It was the very love of God that was poured into our hearts through the Spirit” (Romans 5: 5). It gives divine life to our souls now and immortality to our bodies at resurrection. It frees us from clinging to material things.

The water that Jesus promises is closely linked to conversion and forgiveness of sin. Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. But the sin must first be confessed and acknowledged. Jesus’ encounter with the Samaritan woman caused the change in her life. She decided to change her life and then wanted to shout out to the world that she had an experience of the Messiah who forgives her sin. The woman was filled with joy and rushed to the town, to her people, to tell them about Christ Jesus. They saw that the woman had changed, and for the first time they saw that she was happy. Many Samaritans came to believe in Jesus because of the woman’s witnessing. Then they invited him to stay with them.

In the middle of Lent, Jesus asks us to come to the living water, come to the only one who can satisfy our thirst. Lent is a special time for spiritual recollection and the renewal for the entire community. Lenten prayers, fasting and good works offer us a precious opportunity to drink this life-giving water to the full and share it with others as well. Our Lord Jesus is here with us to satisfy our thirst for eternal life.

### St. Patrick's Day Dispensation

A general dispensation has been granted by Archbishop Hebda from the obligation of abstinence from meat on Friday, March 17, 2023, the Memorial of Saint Patrick.

**DISPENSE FROM THE OBLIGATION OF ABSTINENCE ON MARCH 17, 2023** Those faithful domiciled or physically present in the territory of the Archdiocese who would ordinarily be bound to observe abstinence from meat on the Fridays of the season of Lent. All, however, who choose to enjoy the favor of the dispensation by partaking in the eating of meat on the Memorial of Saint Patrick this year, are exhorted to undertake a work of charity, an exercise of piety, or an act of comparable penance on some other occasion during the Third Week of Lent.

Through the intercession of Saint Patrick, may Christ be in the heart of everyone who thinks of us, in the mouth of everyone who speaks of us, in every eye that sees us, and in every ear that hears us.

Glorious Saint Patrick pray for us!


